I am pleased to invite you to send nominations of suitable candidates to participate in the EANM Focus 3: The International Conference on “Molecular Imaging and Thearagnostics in Neuroendocrine Tumours” within the framework of the IAEA technical cooperation project RER6037, "Strengthening Nuclear Medicine Capabilities".

The purpose of the event is to provide an in-depth overview and critical assessment of the latest development and future directions in the management of neuroendocrine tumours, with a focus on the role of molecular imaging and radionuclide therapies. Participants will also receive an allowance from the IAEA sufficient to cover their costs of lodging, daily subsistence and miscellaneous expenses for the duration of the event in line with IAEA rules and procedures.
