I am pleased to inform you that the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is organizing the above event under the IAEA technical cooperation project RER6041, "Enhancing and Harmonizing Nuclear Medicine and Diagnostic Imaging Capabilities".

The purpose of the workshop is to lecture about Inflammation imaging (imaging inflammatory cells pre-clinical and clinical; imaging inflammatory molecules pre-clinical and clinical), Infection imaging (WBC, FDG-PET, microbial imaging pre-clinical and clinical).

Selection of participants will be in accordance with IAEA procedures. Member States are strongly encouraged to identify women participants.

The IAEA will provide non-local participants with a round-trip air ticket based on the most direct and economical route between the airport nearest the participant's residence and Rome or a travel allowance to purchase an air ticket. Travel details will be agreed with the participants upon receipt of their official nomination. Participants will also receive an allowance from the IAEA sufficient to cover their costs of lodging, daily subsistence and miscellaneous expenses for the duration of the event in line with IAEA rules and procedures.
